# **INSTRUCTIONS / GUIDELINES FOR PARTICIPANTS**

- 1. Tournament: CBSE Cluster-II Table Tennis is scheduled from 13th to 14th October, 2019.
- 2. Every school can send one team comprising of maximum four players, in Under 14, Under 17 & Under 19 yrs separately in Boys & Girls category.
- 3. (i) In Boys in each Category, the team shall consist of maximum four & minimum three players.
  - (ii) In Girls in each Category, the team shall consist of maximum four & minimum two players.
- 4. Age groups :
  - Under 14 years: Born on or after 01.01.2006
  - Under 17 years: Born on or after 01.01.2003
  - Under 19 years: Born on or after 01.01.2001

- 6. **Inauguration:** The first match will be held on 13.10.2019 at 8:00 AM. The inaugural ceremony is scheduled on 12.10.2019 at 5:30 PM.
- 7. **Valedictory Function:** Valedictory function will be held on 14th of Oct. evening. Returning reservation may be made by the participating schools accordingly on 15.10.2019.
- 8. Last Date of Entry: 07.10.2019 as per CBSE Guidelines.
- 9. **Reporting Date & Time Meeting :** Reporting date is 12th of Oct. 2019 at 9.00 AM and meeting to finalise the fixture will be held on same day (12.10.2019) evening after the opening ceremony.
- 10. Accommodation: Teams will be provided accommodation separately for boys and girls. Teams will be responsible for their belongings and are requested not to carry any jewellery, cash money or valuable items.
- 11. Parents are not allowed to stay in the accommodation provided by the school.
- 12. **Essential:** The girls' team must be escorted by a lady teacher. All teams are requested to bring lock-key, torch, towel, school flag, Student Identity card for each player, playing kits.
- 13. **Lodging & Fooding Charges :** Nutritions food will be served @ (Rs 350/) Per head per day as per CBSE rules for participants and teacher/ staff accompanying them.
  - The participating schools will deposit payments against meals on full day basis and two part payment will be accepted and the participating schools will not insist for refund of part payment.
- 14. Security deposit of Rs. 3000/- (Rs. Three Thousand only) will also be made by each team at the time of entry which is refundable.

- 16. **Transport Facilities:** Transport facilities are available from Durg Railway Station and Power House, Bhilai, Railway Station and other Bhilai Bus stands on prior information.

# 17. Important Information :

- a. A group photograph (Separate Team) of players, Coach/Manager with Principal duly attested by principal.
- b. The participants studying in Class XI & XII are requested to produce their attested Xerox copy of the mark sheet of class X Board Examination.
- c. All the participating teams shall compete in the tournament in their respective school uniform.

- 20. No team will be allowed to participate without team Manager/coach. Guest participants should be escorted by female escorts (Manager).
- 21. Over age player or player from outside school agency : In case a school fields an over-age player or player from outside agency, and is caught, the school will immediately be disqualified. And if the same school repeats such act again, its name will be forwarded to the Board's Affiliation Branch for necessary action under Affiliation Bye Laws.

# 22. **Disqualifications**:

A player/team may be disqualified/scratched for the following reasons.

- i. If the ineligibility of any member of the team is detected.
- ii. Inclusion of non bonafide student in the team.
- iii. Misbehaviour on ground by athlete or accompanying official.
- iv. Use of abusive language by athlete or accompanying official.
- v. Misbehaviour with Officials/Opponents by athlete or accompanying official.
- vi. Indiscipline at the place of stay by athlete or accompanying official.
- vii. Damaging the school property.
- viii. Indiscipline during the Opening and Closing ceremonies by athlete or accompanying official.
- ix. Non participation in March Past.
- x. A student, who has failed twice in a particular class, shall no more be eligible to participate.

# 23. **Protest**:

Protest of any nature in connection with the tournament shall be in writing and must reach the Organizing Secretary and CBSE Observer within one hour of the declaration of the result, duly accompanied by a fee of Rs.1000/- (Rupees One Thousand).

Such a protest will be considered by Jury of Appeal, consisting of following:-

- i. Principal, Organizing School
- ii. Organizing Secretary
- iii. CBSE Observer
- iv. One or two technically qualified People present at the venue

The parties under dispute may be heard before deciding the issue. In case the protest is uphold, the protest fee shall be refunded to the protesting school otherwise the fee shall be forfeited.

- 24. **Important :** It shall be mandatory for all the participating schools to provide the following on arrival at venue :
  - i. The documents for verification in original if asked for.
  - ii. The team photo with school Principal along with the entry Performa, countersigned by the concerned Principal.
  - iii. To provide CBSE registration number for student/player studying in class IX and above.
  - iv. To supply the eligibility performa filled-in online, countersigned by the concerned Principal.
  - v. The Performa in disciplines like, Judo & Swimming shall include the event/weight category the athlete wishes to participate.

# 25. Mandatory Requirements :

- i. Team Manager/Coaches shall provide the required documents for verification in original, if asked for by the controller.
- ii. Team photo with school principal along with the entry Performa duly countersigned by the concerned principal shall be produced at the time of entry in the School Campus.
- iii. For Students studying in class IX and above shall provide CBSE Registration Number given.
- iv. Identity Cards to be brought by the students and coaches duly stamped and signed by the Principal.
- v. Proof of the payment of CBSE Annual Sports fee for the year 2019-20
- vi. Girl participants should be escorted by Female Escorts (Manager).

# 26. Withdrawing School :

If a school, after filling-in its entry, wishes to withdraw from a tournament/meet, it shall give a written request of its intention to do so to the Organizing Secretary/School.

School withdrawing without informing/requesting the Organizing school, will be penalized with a penalty of Rs.1000/-.

27. In case the player/team is being accompanied only by the parent, it should be informed by the Principal of participating school in writing.
